tion of state centralization of the records of defunct educational institutions. On the advice of Dr. F. J. Kelly, of that office, the action of this Association was submitted, through the Office of Education, to the Council of State Superintendents and Commissioners of Education. That body adopted the following resolution:

That we invite the registrars of the several state universities and, in the case of states having no state university, the state colleges, to confer with the state superintendents and commissioners of education in their respective states in the formulation of a bill to be presented to the forthcoming legislatures to provide a safe and accessible depository for student procedure from institutions which become defined

Your committee has had drafted and presents for your approval the following skeleton law embodying the essential features which should be included in the legislation of the several states.

A BILL

For an act to amend General Statutes of ---- ---- .__, relating to the granting of diplomas by colleges and other institutions of learning and relating to the perpetuation of their school records. Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State
