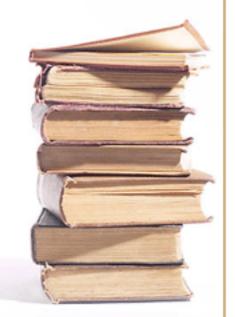

 Main campus implemented "cold turkey" Fall 2001

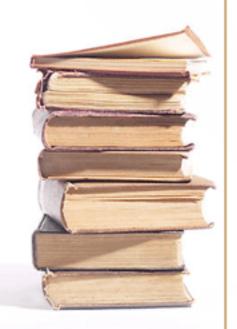
 Later added reports for departments and RO use

 Added Law School Fall 2002

### Benefits of Online Grades

- Faculty access to rosters anytime/anyplace
- Secure, controlled access
- Tracking reports tell us what is outstanding at any moment
- Running over 99% every term since inception

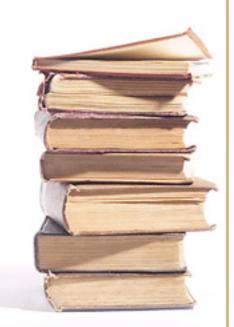

Total February 2006 to February 2007

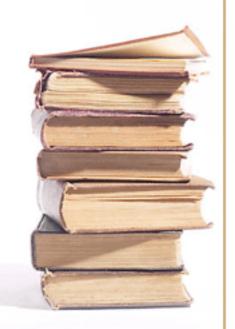

### Considerations for Design

- All faculty legislation must be enforced\*\*
- All procedural rules must be enforced\*\*
- Access only the faculty member who taught the course can change a grade

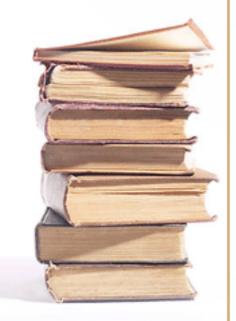

### More Considerations

- Grading Options must remain enforced (can't change from a C to a Pass)
- System must record who made change, when and for what reason; audit reports needed
- Timing of grade change availability: when can changes begin?

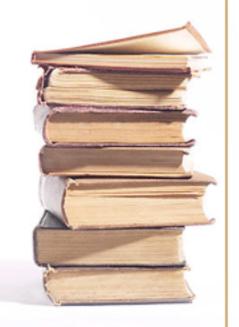
### Faculty Legislation Examples

- No grade changes allowed 30 days after the award of the degree
- No Incompletes for Graduate Students allowed after one year
- No grade changes to grades coded AD (conduct cases)



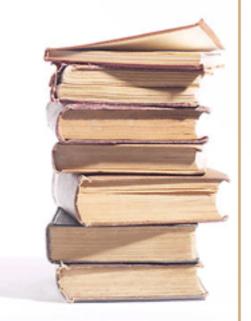
### Procedural Rule Examples

- No grade changes back to "I" for Incompletes that were converted to "F"
- No grade changes for Audits or Withdrawals
- No grade changes for graduate student thesis or dissertation "I."



# Timing of Availability

- Online Grades that have been submitted are rolled twice daily (7:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m.) during the tenday grading period.
- As soon as grades "roll," the menus change in DuckWeb for Faculty and changes can be made.

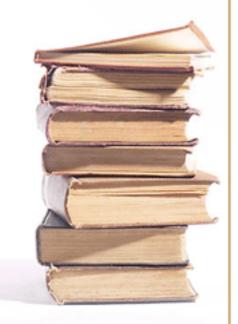






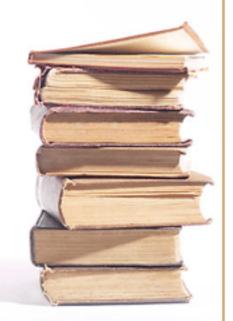
# Online Class List vs. Online Supplemental Grade Roster

- Class list provides snapshot of what was submitted at grade time
- Supplemental Grade
   Roster shows current
   grades for each student



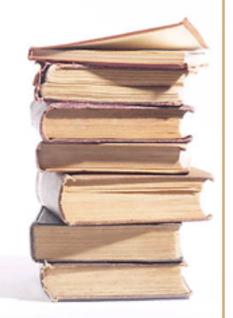
# Grade Change Reports

- Used by both Registrar and Departments
- Data by Department or by Instructor
- Qualify on Term and Start Date



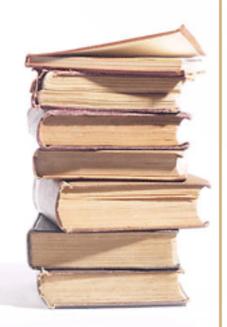
### Grade Change Reports

- Registrar's Office audits for
  - changes made to grades of staff and student employees
  - Anything out of the ordinary
- Departments monitor activity for their own faculty and courses



# Grade Change Reports

- Reports include
  - Term
  - CRN
  - Subject and course number, course title
  - Instructor
  - Student Name and ID
  - Old Grade and New Grade
  - Reason for Change
  - Grade mode (graded or P/NP)
  - Credits
  - User ID and date of change
- Sorted by term, then Subject/#

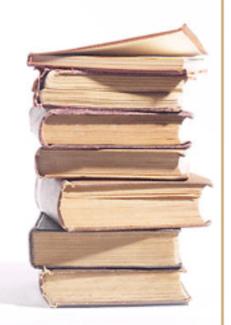


# Change Codes in Use Online

• RI: Remove an Incomplete

LG: Late Grade

IC: Instructor Change



### Benefits of the Online System

- Less risk of paper copies getting misused
- Fewer paper SGR forms needed (save printing costs)
- Changes can only be made by the faculty member (system requires authentication)



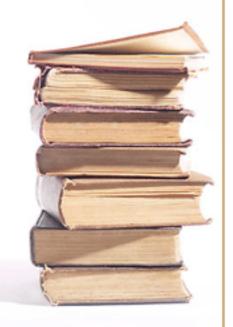
### Benefits of the Online System

- Faster (no campus mailing of forms to Registrar's Office for a human to process)
- No filing, filming, archiving grade changes to satisfy retention requirements ("Born electronic stays electronic.")



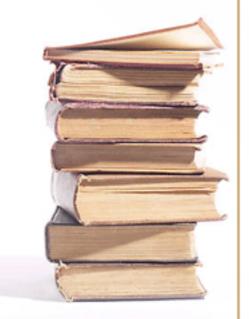
### Benefits

- On-demand auditing (no more carbon copies to be mailed back, checked, retained for 1 year by departments)
- Instant update to Banner and Self-Serve: student can see new grade immediately; new degree audit runs overnight.

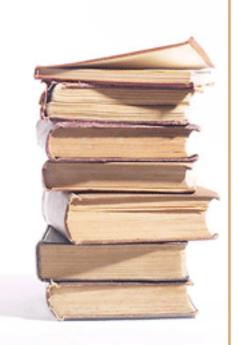


### Issues to Deal With

- Ensuring Departmental Partners run audit report regularly
- Ensuring Departmental Partners retain the few paper SGR forms they do receive
- Regular review of grade changes by faculty who are no longer with the university
